



## Application Information and Deadlines

This information is supplied so you understand the application process. **You should never indicate a student's chances of admission, or when they should apply.** Questions on applications should be directed to [admissions@nd.edu](mailto:admissions@nd.edu).

### Submitting an application

Notre Dame accepts the [Common Application](#), the [Coalition Application](#), and the [QuestBridge Application](#). A completed application contains:

- The Notre Dame Writing Supplement via the Common Application or Coalition Application
- The Notre Dame Supplement (QuestBridge only)
- Self-reported or official results of your ACT or SAT assessment scores if not applying test optional
- Official high school transcripts or record of academic achievement in secondary school
- A letter of evaluation from a high school teacher in a core academic subject area who knows you well
- Counselor evaluation (recommended, not required)
- A non-refundable application fee of \$75
- Students will be notified when their application is complete or if any items are missing from their application

### Application Deadlines

#### *Restrictive Early Action*

- Deadline: November 1
- Notification: Mid-December
- A student applying Restrictive Early Action to Notre Dame may apply to other colleges with Early Action programs, but may **not** apply to any other college or university in their binding Early Decision process. Students do not indicate a first-choice preference by applying early and still may wait until May 1 to indicate their decision to attend.

#### *Regular Decision*

- Deadline: January 1
- Notification: By the first week of April

### Possible Admissions Decisions

#### *Restrictive Early Action*

- Admission to the University
- Denial of Admission to the University
- Deferral of Decision until Regular Decision

Admitted students have until the May 1 deadline to decide whether they would like confirm their attendance at the University. If a student is denied admissions in Early Action, the process ends and he or she cannot apply later during Regular Decision. If a student is deferred, the Admissions Committee has decided to review the application further in the Regular Decision process, and the application "rolls over" to Regular Decision.

#### *Regular Decision*

- Admission to the University
- Denial of Admission to the University
- Waiting List

Students who are waitlisted will receive a final admission decision by the end of June. The Admissions Committee waitlists students who would be viable candidates for admission should additional room become available in the First Year class.
